A short term cash crop which could earn a

farmer \$14,475 from one hectare.

Recommended Varieties.

- Scarlet O'hara
- Chantenary
- New Kuroda
- New Kuroda improved
- **Baby Carrot**

Expected Yield

10 - 15 tonnes/ha

Soil Requirement

Requires a well drained, well structured alluvial soil with good moisture holding capacity.

Planting Time

Carrots prefer cool season growing conditions with optimum growing temperature of 15 - 20°C.



Seed Rate

2.5 to 4.0kg/ha

Spacing

- 50 75cm between rows
- 8 10cm within rows

Land Preparation

Two ploughing and two harrowing is recommended for good soil tilth.

Method of Planting

Direct sowing on very well prepared fine soil.

Fertilizer Requirement

- Poultry manure 10 tonnes/ha basal application.
- NPK 13:13:21-200 kg/ha basal application.
- Urea 100kg/ha top dress when plants are 3 to 5cm in height.

Note: Keep Urea away from plant base (carry out foliar application for quick response).

Weed Control

- Weeds Apply Linuron as a preemergence at 1.5kg/ha.
- Hand weeding and hilling is also recommended

Pest Control

- Aphids Spray Dimethioate at 15ml/15L of water (Sold as Rogor)
- Cutworms Spray Acephate 75%

a.i at 20g/15L of water (Acephate is sold as Orthene & Sunthene) or Endosulfan at 10ml/15L of water.

Disease Control

- Alternaria leaf blight make good drains and dust seeds with Mancozeb.
- Nematodes avoid areas known to be infested Root Knot Nematode. Practice crop rotation.
- Soft Rot apply Mancozeb at 50g/15L of water or Copper Oxychloride at 60g/15L of water (Sold as KOPI) or Use Kocide at 30g/15L of water to prevent fungal infections

Harvesting

Water beds lightly and pullout carrots gently. Harvest after 15-18 weeks from planting.

Storage

For maximum storage carrots should be



cool stored at 0°c and 90 - 100% relative humidity.

Expected storage time for topped carrots 5 weeks. Carrots are sensitive to ethylene present in the storage atmosphere and effective storage time will be reduced.

15. Returns

For the yield of 10 - 15 tonnes/ha if sold at \$1.50/kg can give a gross income of \$15,000 - \$22,500/ha.

16. Food Value

Carrot is a good source of dietary fibre, potassium, vitamin A and vitamin C.


