POSITION PURPOSE

The position is responsible to Senior Research Officer Pasture through implementation and management of livestock nutritional trials, collecting data, pasture sampling, pasture renovation and maintenance, carrying out all the nutritional related field activities at Sigatoka Research Station.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

The position will achieve its purpose through the following key duties.

- 1. Implementation of approved station work program
- 2. Ensure all nutritional trials are managed properly.
- 3. Monitoring the nutrition status in the field for all livestock at Sigatoka Research Station
- 4. Record and submit accurate field data to the supervisor for records.
- 5. Assist in collection of trial data
- 6. Actively contribute to all corporate requirements of the ministry including planned activities as and when required

KEY PERFORMANCE INDICATORS

Performance will be measured through the following indicators:

- 1. The staff should carry out timely field reporting, management and husbandry practices on livestock nutrition in compliance with animal welfare and safety.
- 2. Implementation of approved action plans and programs as stated in AH&P Division Business Plan and carry out activities in compliance with policies, procedure manuals, service standards and other applicable legislation.

PERSON SPECIFICATION

The applicant must have a pass in Fiji Junior Certificate or equivalent with some agricultural background and possess skills and knowledge on animal husbandry and management.
